

# **Strath Union Elections - Voting Guidance 2019**

In order to vote, you need to a) be a student at Strathclyde University and b) have shared your data with the Students' Union. If you haven't done this yet, you can share your data by logging into Pegasus.

If you have any questions, you can look through the elections webpage at <u>www.strathunion.com/elections</u>. You can also contact <u>strath.dem@strath.ac.uk</u> or ask a member of Union Staff on Level 7 or at a polling station.

- 1. Search www.strathunion.com/elections
- Log in to the website click the corner of the webpage where it says 'log-in' and then select 'student login'.

This will direct you to an external page where you can put in your details – this should be the same as your DS log in details.
