Holistic Student Support and Fee Administration Review

- Proposal to include practice of Financial Assurance step within admissions process
- Collect data on proportion on widening access students in PT/Flexible vs full-time study
- Research to be conducted on other insitutions with monthly fee payments
- Draft of new student debt policy currently underway

- Forecast potential spend after gathering data from the Participation Fund usage over the past few years
- A lot of the funding goes towards sport/active health initiatives at the moment

Sports Leadership and Development

- Looking into potential of a pilot around the Accelarate Project
- Meeting arranged with local primary schools to identify gaps in current programmes and developments required to suit the school's needs









Diversity in Staff Community

- Carried out in line with Race Equality Charter work, current key challenges include gaps in data,
 insufficient understanding of people's experiences
- Currently looking into providing two work experience opportunities for BPOC students within Careers and Employability

Celebrate Diverse Student Culture

- Work currently being carried out at Strath Union to adopt inclusive and diverse messaging
- Liasing with University Comms to ensure that a consistent message is present in communications go to students from both the Union and University



Ethical Investment

- Ongoing conversations between the Student Exec and University Secretary, ensuring collaboration is present at every stage of the policy
- Chief Financial Officer currently creating draft to take to University Executive team

- Data from previous years currently being reviewed to identify trends/pressure points to identify needs of students, with a specific focus on Stepps
- Research being conducted into amount spent at external venues to help facilitate what is unable to fit in Strath Sport venue
