



Student Parliament 1 - 30.10.2018 – Summary

Approval of Previous Minutes

The minute from the previous meeting (26th March 2018) were approved.

Executive Accountability

Officers invited questions on their work, including manifesto pledges and campaigns. Some questions were asked to the Vice President Support about mental health campaigns and increasing fees.

Trustee Board

- Policy Update

Student Parliament were asked to ratify a recommendation from Trustee Board to remove USSA Resolves 1 from the policy 'No Platform to Anti-Choice!'. This recommendation was ratified, meaning that the section of the policy has been removed. The remainder of this policy is still live.

- Ratification of new trustees

Student Parliament were asked to ratify new trustees to the Trustee Board – this recommendation was ratified.

Student Parliament Online Ballot Proposal

Parliament decided that they did not have enough information to vote on this. A working group will be created to research into this proposal further and will bring a new proposal back to the next Parliament.

Policy Proposals

a) Student Partnership Agreement

The Student Partnership Agreement was presented to Parliament – this was not passed.

b) Strath Union Supports Striking Students

This proposal was passed by Parliament and is now Students' Union Policy.

Lapsing Policy

Parliament decided that the best course of action would be for the Executive to meet to go through the lapsing policies and provide a recommendation at the next Student Parliament.
