**2. Student's Mental Health Agreement 2023/2024***Feedback*

As of writing this report, I want to notify members of parliament of the progress of this work. The Student Mental Health Agreement is a collaborative agreement between the university and the student's union that embodies the commitments made by both parties to work in partnership to ensure that the mental health and wellbeing of students is kept at the forefront of all activity and operations.

Since the last agreement was made in 2021/2022, it must be updated to reflect the most recent events that have an impact on students' mental health. The working group which was led by the VP welfare and a university staff from the disability and wellbeing service, decided to collate services, activities and offers that promote student's mental health from 2022 up to second semester of the 2023/2024 session and would like student's input to shape interventions and activities for the 2024/2025 session.

To accomplish this, the working group would arrange **FOCUS GROUP** sessions, which would be led by a working group member. Student comments would then be collected and compiled to shape the agreement moving ahead. More details regarding the focus groups would be provided by the time of parliament. It would be desirable for members of parliament to actively participate in the progress of this agreement.

**3. No Homeless Student Campaign/Housing Action Group***Information*

The work on this campaign to reduce student's homelessness has led to my involvement with university accommodation services, the estate consultation group, Unipol advisory group and most recently 'Evicted Scotland'- A BBC documentary capturing stories of people who have faced unfair eviction. (Please reach out to me if yourself or any student you know who like to be involved in this). A major campaign demand was for the university to become a guarantor for students who do not have one. They have promised to include this to the 2024/2025 budget, more info on this would be relayed in the next parliament.
