## What is a programme rep?

The primary role of a programme rep is to collect the views of students and represent these in SSLC meetings to make improvements and identify solutions.

## What is expected of a programme rep?

- Attend training sessions organised by Strathclyde Students' Union.
- Act as the main channel of communication between students and department staff.
- Ensure that they are easily contactable and proactive in collecting feedback.
- Attend SSLC meetings to represent the views of their cohort.
- Send apologies to meeting convener if unable to attend with 24 hours' notice - this does not apply for illness.
- Work with their department reps to make continuous improvements in their department and raise any issues.
